### **FOSSIL MYSTERIES**

From dinosaurs to mammoths, discover the rich fossil history of our region. In this major exhibition, created by the Museum, ponder a mystery, examine the strong fossil evidence from the Museum's collection, and use scientific tools to discover answers. Traveling through a 75-million-year timeline, from the age of dinosaurs to the Ice Ages, experience an unfolding of the prehistory of southern California and Baja California, Mexico. **See 12 giant murals by William Stout depicting the prehistoric history of southern and Baja California.**

### **DINOSAURS: REEL & ROBOTIC**

An exciting exhibition that shows how dinosaurs first came to life in the movies, featuring the largest and most complete collection of dinosaur movie posters in the world. See Stout's original illustrations demonstrating the conceptual development of how dinosaurs should appear in the Disney movie *Dinosaur*. Also, see Ray Harryhausen's work on such films as *Beast from 20,000 Fathoms*. Through January 1, 2007.
